WHAT IS IGNITE CONFIRMATION?

IGNITE Confirmation is a three-year program that begins in the fall of the 7th grade year with IGNITE 7 and concludes with a three-part Celebration of Confirmation in the spring of their 9th grade year. At the Service of Confirmation those students who have chosen to be Confirmed will publicly affirm their faith as they respond to the following question:

Do you intend to continue to trust in the covenant God made with you in Holy Baptism:

- To live among God's faithful people
- To hear God's Word and share in God's supper
- To proclaim the Good News of God in Christ, through word and deed
- To serve all people, following the example of Jesus
- And to strive for justice and peace in all the earth

Confirmation is a process of learning and preparation that is structured around this promise and Incarnation's Mission, Vision, and Values. The goal is to equip young people so they can answer this question of Confirmation faithfully. More than that, the goal is to nurture these young people in their faith development as they explore what it means to live as followers of Jesus Christ and discover the gift of living in God's abundant and forgiving love. We also want to introduce them to some of the essential practices of faithful living, including: reading and studying the Word of God found in the Bible, prayer, service to others, sharing our gifts, talents, and resources, and expressing our faith through words and actions.

As leaders at Incarnation, we have worked hard to build a strong Confirmation ministry for the sake of your child's faith. ***Confirmation is a voluntary program, not a sacrament.*** By registering your child, you are making a commitment to support them through this process. This handbook is your guide to the elements and expectations of this program. It will help you understand how things work and what is expected of your child and of you as a Confirmation parent. Your child's experience depends on how well we partner together as parents, Confirmation Guides, and Incarnation staff.

ELEMENTS OF THE IGNITE 7 AND IGNITE 8 PROGRAM

When you look at the Confirmation calendar, you will see that there are three types of events that make up our Confirmation ministry.

Learning Events

Learning Events are interactive small group time dedicated to understanding more about God and how we live the Christian life by exploring the Bible as the Word of God and through the teachings of Martin Luther's Small Catechism.

Most of our sessions are Learning Events, on those nights people registered for Session One meet in their small groups from 5:30 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. and then travel as a group to Incarnation Hall for large group worship which will last until 7:00 p.m. Those registered for Session Two will meet their small group in their assigned row in Incarnation Hall and participate in large group worship from 6:30 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. before going to their small groups from 7:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. Please note that students who wish to participate in organized music (Good News Singers or Chapel Bells) at Incarnation will need to register for Session Two.

Serve/Fellowship Events

A Servant Event is an evening designated for serving as a small group either inside or outside Incarnation. Serve Events are coordinated by each small group's Guide. Each small group will participate in at least one Serve Event. These events happen on designated nights (noted on your calendar), but sometimes happen at different times than your normal meeting times or may happen at different place. There are nights built into the IGNITE 7/8 Calendar for these events to take place; but, occasionally, due to the interest of the small group members, service projects will be scheduled at an alternate time (for example serving a Lenten Soup supper). Small Group Guides are responsible for communicating the details to parents. If you don't know what is happening, it is important to be in contact with your child's Guide about these events.

In order to help small groups get connected and grow closer as a group, there will periodically be opportunities for fellowship and fun, both as a large group and in small groups. Note these dates on the calendar and please be aware that there may be a change in time or location. Small Group Serve/Fellowship are listed for the same nights on the calendar. Each small group will determine what they will do on a particular night. Please consider helping your child's Guide out in planning or driving for these events. Our Child Protection Policy requires all volunteers to fill out a background check form and sign a volunteer covenant. Also, all drivers may be subject to a review of their driving records.

Expectations and Requirements

Because Confirmation is a voluntary program, by registering your child you are committing to the following expectations for yourself and your child. In the fall you and your child will receive a form to help you keep track of your student's progress. **All requirements must be completed by June 30, 2019.**

Weekly Participation

Regular attendance and participation in all Confirmation events is so important for your child's faith development and bonding within the small group. Please make sure your child is present with their gear: their Bible, Confirmation bag and a pen or pencil. The bag will be given to them on the first night of Confirmation.

Worship Attendance/Reflection Sheets

Gathering in worship is central to our faith and life. Because we want to help students develop the practice of worshipping regularly, *IGNITE 7/8 students are expected to turn in 16 reflection sheets* that allow them to reflect on their experience in worship. We have simplified the reflection sheet form so that it is less worrisome for students but still gives us a connection with each student.

Reflection sheets are available on the Information Desk in the Atrium outside the Sanctuary and on a table inside Incarnation Hall. Your child should pick one up before worship and return it to the same location after worship. Please encourage your student to respond thoughtfully. Each sheet will be read and recorded. You can check our website (<http://incarnationmn.org/youth/ignite-confirmation-7-9/reflection-sheets-service-hours/>) weekly to check on your child's progress. You can also download a reflection sheet for use when you are worshipping elsewhere. There are two options for Reflection Sheets, one can be done by your child alone and asks three reflective questions and is worth one sheet. The other invites you and your child to have a conversation about your experience in worship. Since this requires more effort it is worth two reflection sheets.

Of the 16 required reflection sheets, 12 must be from worship at Incarnation. Worshipping here at Incarnation is important for the consistency of the theological message between Confirmation and worship and for how we participate in the life of this community of faith. If worshipping on Sunday morning is a challenge because of sports schedules or other family commitments, remember that Incarnation also has a Sunday evening worship service at 6:00 p.m. in Incarnation Hall.

If your child is worshipping away from Incarnation, they still need to complete a reflection sheet to get credit. Have them save a bulletin and use it to complete a reflection sheet downloaded from the IGNITE 7/8 web page. Please attach the bulletin to the reflection sheet when you turn it in.

During the season of Lent, Confirmation small groups will not meet so that families can worship together during mid-week Lenten worship. Lent is a great time to get caught up on reflection sheets if your child has fallen behind.

If your family situation (i.e. shared custody) makes it difficult for you and your child to worship regularly on Sundays, please connect with Shawna so that we can develop an alternate plan together.

Retreats

Retreats are a more intensive time of connecting and learning. It is a chance to break out of the normal routine and focus on a particular aspect of our relationship with God. If you have an IGNITE 8 student, you have a required retreat. Please mark your calendar now with this retreat date:

IGNITE 8 – Friday, October 26 – Saturday October 27

The IGNITE 8 “Life Choices” retreat will be an overnight at Incarnation. This retreat allows us to go deeper as we talk about how our faith shapes choices we make in our life, including choices about sex, technology and what those choices may mean for our future.

Called to Serve: Service in Support of the Ministries of Incarnation

One of the ways that we express our faith as Christians is through service. For that reason we ask students to complete at least four service hours (depending on the type of service they choose) that support the ministries of Incarnation.

There are many different ways to serve and we want to help your student find an opportunity that fits. Opportunities include: acolyting, working in the nursery, assisting with Sunday school, ushering, participating in music, serving Sunday treats, or other special projects. Please note that some opportunities are limited and assigned on a first come, first served basis.

For descriptions, read the “Called to Serve” registration form and have your child choose one area in which they will participate. Students register for their service opportunity at registration on April 25th. In the fall you will receive the schedule of your service assignments,

the contact person for your area, and a list of others who are serving in that way. *We depend on our Confirmation students in these important service/leadership roles. If your child is not able to serve on their assigned day(s), you are responsible for finding a substitute from your list.*

To receive credit for service hours for music, ushering, acolyting, Sunday treat serving, nursery or Sunday School, students must sign the clipboard located on the Information Center in the Atrium (near the Sanctuary).

Called to Serve: Service in the Wider Community

Additionally, Confirmation students are expected to complete two hours of service outside of Incarnation. To receive credit for service in the community, students will write a paragraph about what they did and have parents or service coordinator sign it. After completing these hours, and writing their paragraph students can turn in their paragraph to the Incarnation Office or place it in the tray where reflection sheets are collected.

IGNITE 8 Mentoring During Lent

All IGNITE 8 Students will be asked to choose a Faith Mentor that they will meet with during Lent to have some Faith conversations, and to begin to build a mentoring relationship. It is our hope, that this Faith Mentor will also serve as their Prayer Partner as a 9th grade Confirmand when they are preparing to be confirmed. Students can choose their own Faith Mentor, or we will help pair them with one if they do not have an idea of a specific Faith Mentor. Mentors and Students will need to meet for 3 sessions (each session is ½ hour long). Parents and students will receive more information about the mentoring program at the fall IGNITE 8 parent meeting on September 19th at 6:30 p.m.

Parent Partnership Service Hours

Because this is a big program with a lot of moving parts, we need your help to keep things running smoothly. At least one parent is expected to support Confirmation ministry by serving in one of the following ways this year:

Small Group Guide – this is a weekly leadership commitment working directly with a small group of students. Contact Shawna Berg for a detailed position description. Requires a completed background check to fulfill the *Incarnation Lutheran Church Policy for Protecting Children and Youth*.

Substitute Small Group Guide – from time to time we need someone to fill in for a Guide who needs to miss. Requires a completed background check to full the *Incarnation Lutheran Church Policy for Protecting Children and Youth*.

Serving Sunday Treats – this service is done with your child on a Sunday morning. Families will be assigned two, three, or four Sunday shifts, depending on registration, to help serve cookies and provide hospitality for Incarnation families enjoying coffee/cookies after worship services on Sunday morning. You will receive your schedule in the fall.

Serving Summer Treats – this is similar to Sunday treat serving. Parents and children serve together. This service begins on Memorial Day weekend. You will serve three Sundays during the summer and fulfill your service requirement.

Assist with Confirmation Registration April 24, 2019 – this is a two hour commitment on April 24th. The timeframe is between 4:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. The specific times/dates will be determined next spring.

Serving Meals – help prepare and serve a meal to our Confirmands. Commitment is from 4:30 p.m.- 6:30 p.m. on a Wednesday night two to three times per year.

Hallway Monitor/Student Check In – assist with youth supervision by monitoring hallways and bathroom areas to make sure students are in classes. Parents would serve two to three times from 5:20 p.m. - 6:40 p.m. throughout the year.

Please prayerfully consider your gifts and skills as you choose among these opportunities. Make your selection on the same "Called to Serve" registration form where your child chooses their service opportunity.

NUTS & BOLTS

Meals

Meals will be offered in Grace Hall to students and Guides wishing to participate from 5:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. Fees for the meals will be \$100 for one person for the entire year. Family meals are \$350, for the year or \$175 per family per semester (immediate family only). Registration and fees for meals will be taken at the Ice Cream Social on September 12th and at the fall kick-off on Wednesday, September 19.

Discipline/Classroom Control Issues

We expect students to be respectful of guides and one another at all times. Our practice for discipline and for managing classroom control dynamics is to first speak with the student about the offending or disruptive behavior. If the behavior persists, the student will be referred to Shawna Berg. Parents may be asked to attend classes with the student for a period of time. If the behavior still persists, the student may be removed from the IGNITE 7/8 program.

If you are concerned about your child and classroom dynamics, please contact Shawna. We want to work together to create a good learning environment for all participants in the group.

Fees

Fees include all necessary materials, books, activities, and retreats.
