Bible Story: The Lord's Prayer

This week in Wednesday night worship we are focusing on the first phrase, "Our Father in Heaven, hallowed be your name . . ." As a family, read together The Lord's Prayer, found in your SPARK Storybook Bible on pages 278-281. In this story Jesus' disciples ask him to teach them how to pray, Jesus then teaches them the Lord's Prayer. After you read the story consider these questions:

Jesus calls God, "Father". How is God like a good father?

What is another word you can think of that describes God? (strong, loving, powerful, caring, peaceful, trustworthy, etc.)

Use that word to begin a short prayer such as:

God thank you that you are _____.

_____ God, we ask for your help today and pray for our friend who is hurting.

This week we are using the letter tile to remind us that God's word teaches new things about who God is. Pull out your letter and brainstorm together words that begin with that letter that describe God. Throughout the week, see if you can come up with a word that begins with each letter of the alphabet that describes God.

In the box below, draw a picture or write the word in block letters that describes God. Use this as your prayer time today thinking about how God shows you this is who God is.
