Bible Story: The Lord's Prayer

This week in Wednesday night worship we are focusing on the second phrase, "your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as in heaven." As a family, read together The Lord's Prayer, found in your SPARK Storybook Bible on pages 278-281. In this story Jesus' disciples ask him to teach them how to pray, Jesus then teaches them the Lord's Prayer. After you read the story consider these questions:

Read the story "The House on the Rock" in your SPARK Storybook Bible. (pg. 282-285) How is trusting God like building a house on a rock?

How do we know we can trust God? (because God is strong, loving, trustworthy . . . etc.)

Use that word to begin a short prayer such as:

God thank you that you are _____.

_____ God, we ask for your help today and pray for our friend who is hurting.

This week we are using a nail to remind us that God wants us to help build the kingdom on earth. As you look at your nail, think about the ways you can help others through your thoughts, words and actions.
