

## Reflection Questions for *Just Mercy*

1. Was there a scene in the movie that stood out for you? What was it about the scene that was significant for you or caught your attention?
2. What did you notice about your own emotional response during the film? When did you feel anxious, angry, frustrated, surprised, relieved...?
3. Was there a character in the film that you were drawn to or identified with? What was it about that character that drew you in?
4. List the different times when the system was stacked against an individual or group of people in the movie. Which were obvious and which were more subtle?
5. What role did relationships or the community play in the film? What might have been different without those ties?
6. What role did faith and the local church play in the film?
7. The family of the victim was not portrayed in the film. What do you think they would want to tell us?
8. What do you think kept the characters going in times of resistance or challenge? Where did you see examples of resilience?
9. Where did you see signs of hope or forgiveness or redemption?
10. How has the film changed your perspective or understanding, if at all?
