

Reflection Questions for 13th – A Documentary Film

1. What image from the film struck you? What was significant or surprising about that image for you?
2. What is something new that you learned or discovered from the film? What questions did the film bring up for you? What would you like to learn more about?
3. For some of us, portions of the film take place during our lifetime. How do you remember those events or movements? How is the film similar to or different from your own experiences?
4. What was challenging about the film for you?
5. What was encouraging? What is happening in the community today that you find hopeful?
6. Watching the film through the lens of faith, what do you see? What messages of faith speak into this context?
7. What were some of the emotions that came up for you while watching the film?
8. What are any next steps you'd like to take to learn or act, as a result of this film? How does your faith call you to respond, if at all?
