Incarnation partners informally with Global Health Ministries (GHM), an organization founded in 1987 to relieve medical supply shortages and equipment deficits hindering Lutheran healthcare systems around the globe.

HOW GHM ENHANCES HEALTHCARE OVERSEAS

Global Health Ministries steps in to scale the impact of under-resourced medical facilities through three distinct global pathways:

- **Strategic Funding:** Underwriting approved healthcare micro-projects, educational scholarships, facility capital expansions, and technology developments.
- **Logistics & Supply Chains:** Gathering and shipping highly vital, useful donated medical machinery and clinic supplies to countries where these assets are either nonexistent or prohibitively expensive.
- **Human Talent Recruitment:** Screening and deploying nurses, dentists, doctors, surgeons, and skilled technical workers for overseas service vacancies managed through Lutheran mission boards.

HANDS-ON VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

"Getting Our Hands Dirty"

Incarnation stands with GHM through steadfast prayer and active physical labor at their warehouse and processing hubs. Volunteers can step directly into these roles:

- Sorting, categorizing, and inventorying incoming medical equipment.
- Loading large ocean shipping freight containers with packaged supplies.
- Gathering and preparing essential clinical items.
- Repairing, tuning, and reconditioning hardware and medical machinery.
- Operating heavy equipment (e.g., driving a forklift) to manage warehouse inventory.
