## FOOD TRUCK SERVICE SCHEDULE

Food Truck Host Volunteers extend critical hospitality at three recurring locations each week:

## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

### 1. Kitchen & Meal Preparation Team

**Schedule:** Weekdays (Monday through Friday) with multiple shift times available.

**Duties:** Engage in meal prep tasks, manage commercial dishwashing, and help box or load meals securely onto the food truck.

**⚠️ Mandatory Commercial Training:** All kitchen and dish team members must complete an initial practical training orientation held on **Mondays or Tuesdays** inside the Shobi's Table commercial kitchen space at *Christ on Capitol Hill* before claimable shifts open.

### 2. Food Truck Host Team

**Duties:** Welcome patrons, pass out flyers, pour water and coffee, bag fresh meal packages, and share friendly conversations with community members visiting the truck. Volunteers are also welcome to stay behind to assist with post-service dish cleanup if time allows.

## VOLUNTEER GUIDELINES & SAFETY

- **Health Protocols:** Volunteers must monitor their personal health and consider household safety constraints. [cite: 14] Individuals experiencing symptoms of any infectious illness, who are un-vaccinated and high risk, or who are immuno-compromised are strictly requested to stay home.
- **Safety Gear:** All volunteers must bring and wear their own protective face masks during the entirety of their shifts. [cite: 14] On-site gloves are provided completely by Shobi's Table.
- **Youth Eligibility:** Young people aged 12 to 18 are warmly welcome but must remain under the direct supervision of an adult chaperone. A single adult chaperone can supervise up to two youth and counts as an active slot volunteer.
